

# Latin Club of the Year Contest

I. Purpose: This contest is designed as a way for the TSJCL Historian to obtain the pictures, memorabilia and information about the activities of JCL chapters in our state for use in the SCRAPBOOK. (This is NOT the national publicity contest whose purpose is the promotion of Latin and JCL in our communities.)

## II. Rules:

1. Every TSJCL chapter is eligible to enter. It should fall to the Historian of each chapter to collect the pictures and memorabilia for the state historian, since they are already doing this for their scrapbook.
2. The contest is a point system. Everything submitted earns a certain point value and the school with highest score earns the title of the "Latin Club of the Year". Awards will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. These points will NOT be awarded towards sweepstakes. There will also be awards in sub categories: most creative fundraiser, most creative publicity, and best picture. This picture is one for use in the scrapbook not for the photography competition.
3. Any work not submitted with the required components will be disqualified. You must send in a photo and/or memorabilia to enter this contest.
4. The required materials to enter Latin Club of the Year contest include:
  - ✓ *Pictures* that must be identified on the back by the school's name, a description of the activity being portrayed (details below), and the names of people in the photograph.
  - ✓ *Memorabilia* from the club's events. (Examples include the program from the NLHS induction, napkin from JCL dinner at Olive Garden, the sign up in halls about the next JCL meeting, etc.)
  - ✓ *A written description* of the JCL event, meeting or activity taking place in the photograph.

Example:

Oct. 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>

The Victoria JCL took a field trip to the San Antonio Museum of Art JCL Meeting after school. We elected officers and decided to sell candy as our first fundraiser.

5. Bonus points will be given for articles about your Latin club published in a school, district or local paper. Bonus points will also be given for articles published on a school, district or campus website. For articles please send a copy of the article or a link to the web page it is on. (Note; this is not the website contest). TV and radio broadcasts that your Latin club is mentioned in will also get bonus points. Point distribution is stated below. If you do not send in pictures or memorabilia entries on this category will be discarded
6. Television and radio entries must be accompanied by a letter that states the content and length in minutes and seconds, and must be signed by an employee of the station for proper verification.
7. Point System and Judging Criteria:

i.	Pictures	2 points each
ii.	Memorabilia	2 points each
iii.	Written descriptions of JCL event	2 points each
iv.	*Articles (Bonus)	
i.	School Paper	5 points each
ii.	District news letter /paper	8 points each
iii.	Local news paper	10 points each
v.	TV/ Radio time	10 points for every 30 seconds
